



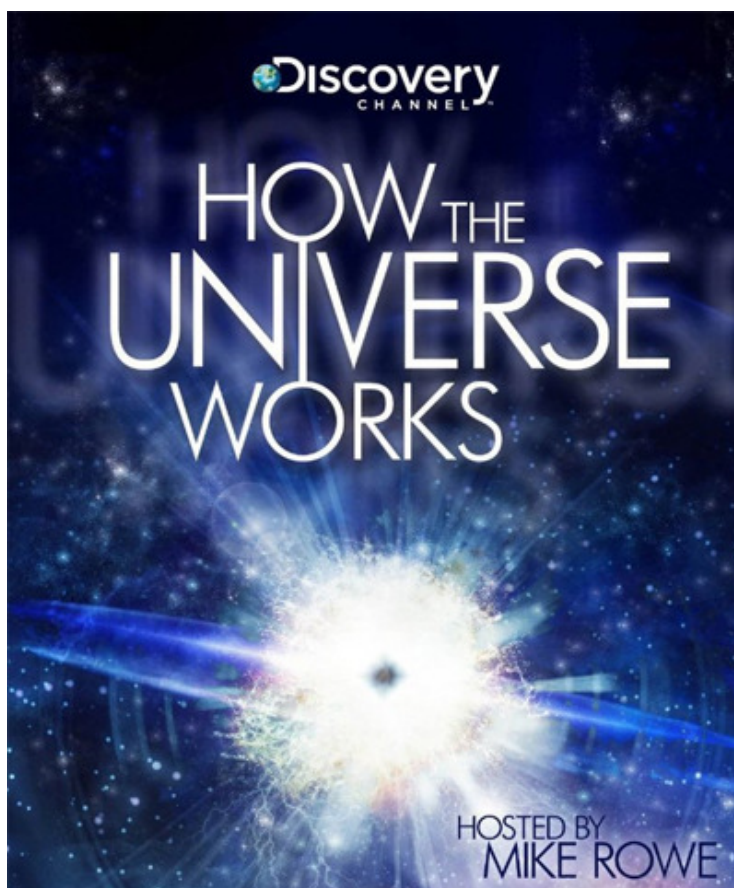

- **\$25.00** - Private Observatory Pad: Assessed to members that have a private observing pad on CAAC property
